GENERAL ORDER NO. 54

The Security Committee will advise on the planning, implementation and continuous review of the court security systems in the District of Idaho. The committee shall meet at least annually or as otherwise ordered by the Chief Judge of the District Court.

The committee will consist of the following individuals or their designees:

1. Chief Judge, U.S. District Court, who shall serve as Chairman;

- 2. The U.S. Marshal;
- 3. The U.S. Attorney;
- 4. Clerk of the District/Bankruptcy Courts;
- 5. The GSA Buildings Manager;
- 6. Chief Judge, U.S. Bankruptcy Court; and
- 7. Circuit Judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court send a copy of this General Order to the individuals appointed to this committee.
