Have you ever wondered how to become a federal judge? Please join Chief United States District Judge David Nye and Chief United States Magistrate Judge Candy Dale on July 15, 2021, at 12:00 MDT, as they discuss the difference in the selection processes for the two upcoming vacancies on the district and magistrate judge bench in Idaho. Judges Nye and Dale will share their personal experiences of navigating the application path and how their paths differ from today's process. In addition, Judge Dale will discuss the District's efforts to promote diversity among the judges on Idaho's federal bench. This program is sponsored by the Diversity and Professionalism and Ethics Sections of the Idaho State Bar, Idaho Women Lawyers, and the Idaho Chapter of the Federal Bar Association.
