Public Access Policy

The library is for the primary use of judges and court personnel with the federal court and is not open to the general public. As a courtesy, the library may be used by attorneys admitted or permitted to practice in this court, bankruptcy trustees, and parties representing themselves, on the days they appear in court. With the permission of a judge, attorneys may use library materials that are not available at the Idaho Supreme Court law library. The library may also be used by attorneys and employees of federal agencies. Use of the library by non-court personnel is permitted from 8:30am to 5:00pm, Monday through Friday, provided the librarian is on duty.
